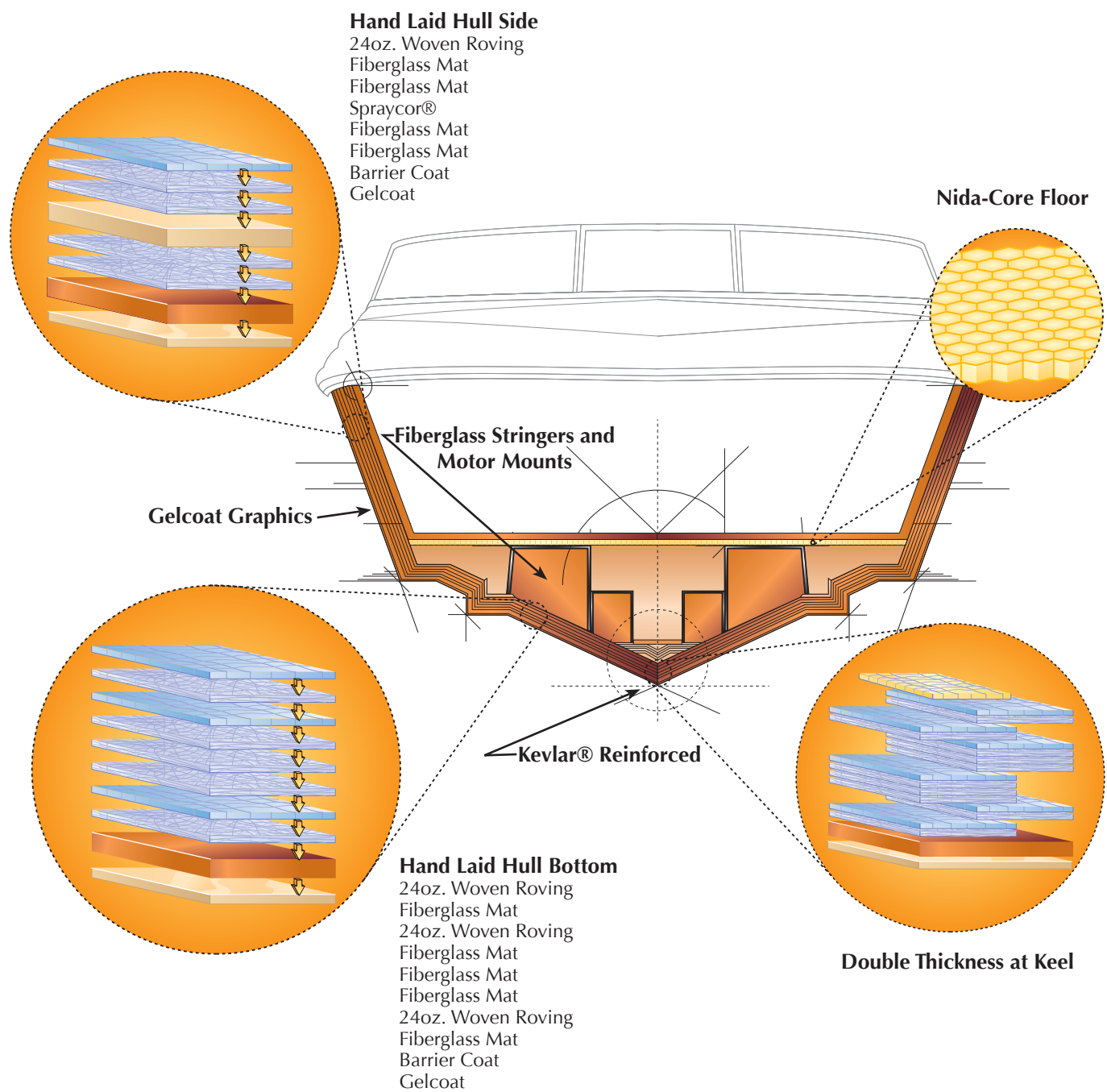

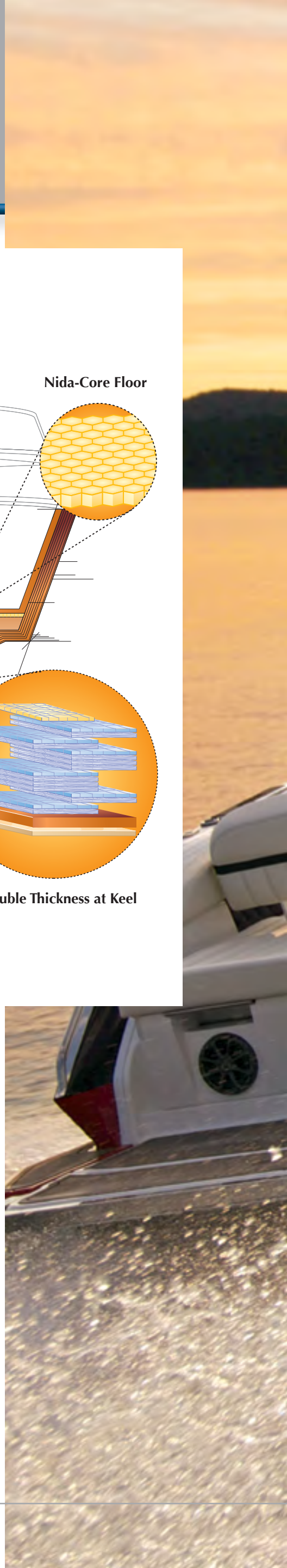

The beauty of a Cobalt boat runs as deep as the deepest ocean. Cobalt's lamination schedule begins with a premium buff-back gel coat which provides the legendary mirror like finish. The barrier layer incorporates a protective barrier coat for a brilliantly smooth base coat and unparalleled blister resistance. Cobalt laminates, by hand, up to 16 alternating layers of fiberglass and woven roving to build a structural hull designed and crafted for a lifetime of boating pleasure. The honeycomb composite coring is integrated in flooring surfaces to optimize strength-to-weight ratios and to maximize sound dampening and vibration resistance. Gelcoat graphic accents ensure that the style lines will stay in style for many years to follow.
